## **Safety Action Meeting Referral Form**

For use by non-government service providers and government agencies other than Police.

All domestic violence victims, whether female or male, identified as at serious threat aged 16 or above in a local area should be referred to a SAM.

To be included on the agenda, victims must be referred to the appropriate LCP.

It is best practice to seek a victim's consent before sharing their information with another service provider, including at or in relation to a SAM. However, in certain limited circumstances Part 13A allows service providers to share information without a victim's consent where it is necessary to prevent or lessen a serious threat to their safety, or the safety of their children or other persons.

to a SAM, not just Police. Non-Police referrals should be sent directly to the SAM Coordinator. If you wish to refer a victim to a SAM, it is important to consider whether they are **currently** at serious threat. There may be victims with a long history of experiencing domestic violence who have complex needs, but who are not currently at serious threat due to domestic violence. It is vital that SAMs remain focused on those victims who are currently at serious threat due to domestic violence. If you are unsure about making a SAM referral, you should call the SAM Coordinator to discuss the matter Please provide background information/ major risk indicators:
